She is a founding member of the Manhattan Chamber Artists and of the Palisades Chamber Players, and appears regularly with the Banat Quartet and the Cantabile Trio. Followers of contemporary music may have seen her at Weill Hall, Merkin Hall, The Kitchen, and other New Music venues. She is concertmaster of Westchester Camerata and is a regular member of the Stamford Symphony, Ridgefield Symphony and the Cara Quartet. She also appears frequently with Hudson Valley Philharmonic and in live radio appearances on WQXR Radio and Minnesota Public Radio's "Live from Landmark" series. Ms. Thomson is a native of Minneapolis, where as a three-time competition winner she performed concerti with orchestras in Saint Paul, Chicago and Green Bay. She received the Master of Music degree from the Manhattan School of Music as a scholarship student of Raphael Bronstein and Ariana Bronne. Ms. Thomson records on the Newport, New World, and Varese-Sarabande labels, and teaches privately and through RiverArts.
