**PAUL GEIDEL (trombone)**, is a professional trombonist, singer, actor, conductor and arranger. As a trombonist, he has played with the Lake George Opera Festival, Norwalk Symphony, Hudson Valley Philharmonic and many other orchestras. He is a long-time member of the New York Gilbert and Sullivan Players (NYGASP) Orchestra, and has also played for virtually every local opera company outside of Lincoln Center, including the Rockland Opera, Taconic Opera, Bronx Opera, New Rochelle Opera and many others. He has also performed with many local Big

Bands and pit orchestras. Paul has a long resume of leading roles in operettas, operas, musicals and even a few plays. Recent local favorite roles include: The Man in the Chair (*Drowsy Chaperone*), Aaron in *Curtains* and John Jasper in *Edwin Drood*. He spent six seasons as Music Director of the Ridgewood Gilbert and Sullivan Opera Company, and has long directed an A Cappella Jazz Ensemble in NYC, which performs many of his arrangements. Paul has for many years been Leader of Song at St. Philip Neri Church in the Bronx.
