VICTORIA DINE (French horn) has held long-term principal French horn positions with the Stamford Symphony (1984-1996), the Chamber Orchestra of New York (1985-1992) and Solisti New York (1982-1990). She has also made frequent appearances with the Orpheus Chamber Orchestra (at Carnegie Hall, on tour, and on recordings for Deutsche Grammophon Records), the Orchestra of St. Luke's, the New York City Ballet, the Metropolitan Opera, the New York City Opera, and in

numerous Broadway musical productions. This past summer (2019), Ms. Dine took part as principal horn with Tundi Production's in Wagner's extraordinary *Tristan und Isolde* at the Latchis Theatre in Brattleboro, Vermont. In the fall of 2012, Vicki appeared as soloist with the Windham Symphony Orchestra, performing Benjamin Britten's *Serenade for Tenor, Horn and String Orchestra*. She has participated in the summer festivals of Marlboro, Aspen and Norfolk and she has recorded for Deutsche Grammophon, Sony Classical and the Marlboro Recording Society. Vicki earned her Masters degree at The Juilliard School and her Bachelor of Fine Arts degree from the Purchase College Conservatory of Music. She grew up in New York City and is the proud mother of three children and one grandson.
